Rural placement (contributes 10% to the overall programme grade)

For this component the class divides into placement groups of approx. 8-10 students. Each group will work as a team with an experienced local facilitator to complete a small project away from KCMC on a practical aspect of health service delivery. At the end of the week each individual student will write a report (1 page limit) and the group will present their findings to the whole class upon return.
