This Open Research Statement outlines LSHTM's commitment to ensuring that there is a research culture of openness that embraces inclusivity, diversity, integrity and accessibility.

3. EXPECTATIONS

LSHTM researchers are encouraged to explore and engage with open research practices that are appropriate to their research disciplines. This includes the following:

1. Research plans, methods, and results should be made available through an independent registry or repository as soon as practicable.
2. Research practices and standards that enable research to be verified and reused should be adopted, where these exist.
3. Opportunities should be provided for relevant stakeholders to collaborate and contribute to the research process.
4. Research papers must be made available in an open access form.
5. Research outputs that underpin research findings – such as data, code, samples, and other information, should be made available through an appropriate repository or enclave, so that they may be accessed and used by others.
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
